Available Scholarships for 2011-2012

HIGH SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIPS *application deadline February 24, 2012, 3 pm.*

Michael Bailey Memorial Scholarship, \$1,000 (renewable for 4 years)

GLHS Junior; minimum 3.3 GPA at the end of 1st trimester junior year; full-time enrollment in post-secondary institution; financial need.

Benjamin R. Baker Memorial Scholarship, \$1,000

GLHS Senior; minimum 2.5 GPA at the end of 1st trimester senior year; participation in Education for Employment (EFE); pursuing post-secondary education related to EFE experience; CAD program emphasis preferred.

Laurie Makin Cartwright Memorial Scholarship, \$1,000

GLHS Senior; minimum 3.5 GPA at the end of 1st trimester senior year; must be 4-year participant in Gull Lake Band and/or PAC; full-time enrollment in college.

Melanie Noel Chojnowski Scholarship, \$250

GLHS Senior; minimum 3.0 GPA at the end of 1st trimester senior year; planning to pursue a career as a registered nurse.

Coca Cola Healthy Lifestyle Scholarship, \$1,000

GLHS Senior; minimum 3.0 GPA; must demonstrate a healthy lifestyle for yourself and the world around you (i.e. exercise, sports, healthy eating habits, etc.); full-time enrollment in a post-secondary institution.

Jim Field Memorial Scholarship, \$900

GLHS Senior; minimum 3.0 at the end of 1st trimester senior year; pursuing a career in business or a related field; preference given to a student who participated on the high school golf team; full-time enrollment in post-secondary institution.

Gull Lake Area Community Volunteers-Men's Group, \$1,000

GLHS Senior; volunteer participation within the Gull Lake or greater Kalamazoo area.

Gull Lake Area Community Volunteers-Women's Group, \$1,000

GLHS Senior; volunteer participation within the Gull Lake or greater Kalamazoo area.

Gull Lake Area Rotary Club Scholarship, \$500

GLHS Senior planning to pursue post-secondary education. Must exemplify the philosophy of the Rotary Four-Way Test.

Gull Lake Education Association Scholarship, \$500

GLHS Senior planning to pursue a career in education.

Gull Lake Education Association Pekkarinen Scholarship, \$500

GLHS Senior planning to pursue a career that was inspired by a teacher.

Ladies of the Lake Scholarship, \$2,000

GLHS Senior; minimum 3.0 GPA at the end of 1st trimester senior year; full-time enrollment in college; planning to enter the medical field.

PACE Scholarships, \$1,000 each to a female and a male recipient

GLHS Senior; minimum 2.5 GPA at the end of the 1st trimester senior year; full-time enrollment in post-secondary institution; preference to Gull Lake athlete on cross country or track team; financial need.

Parker Hannifin Engineering Scholarship, \$1,000

GLHS Senior; minimum 3.0 GPA in core classes at the end of the 1st trimester senior year; full-time enrollment in post-secondary institution; planning to pursue a career in technology and/or engineering.

Frank Quartermaine Memorial Student Athlete Scholarship, \$1,000

GLHS Senior; minimum 3.0 GPA at the end of the 1st trimester senior year; must exemplify character through academics, sports, volunteerism; participation in varsity sport level for at least 2 years; full-time enrollment in post-secondary institution; financial need considered.

Richland-Gull Lake Area Lions Club Scholarship, \$500

GLHS Senior; minimum 2.0 GPA at the end of the 1st trimester senior year; community service experience; full-time enrollment in a post-secondary institution; financial need.

Clare Shoemaker Memorial Scholarship, \$500

GLHS Senior; minimum 2.5 GPA at the end of the 1st trimester senior year; applicants must be compassionate individuals with a high standard of conduct and good character; full-time enrollment in a 4-year college.

Robert W. Smith Memorial Scholarship, \$500

GLHS Senior; minimum 2.5 GPA at the end of the 1st trimester senior year; full-time enrollment in a post-secondary institution; planning to pursue a career as an engineer or in the trades; financial need.

Joan Split Scholarship, \$1,000

GLHS Senior; minimum 3.5 GPA at the end of the 1st trimester senior year; full-time enrollment in a 4-year post-secondary institution; planning to pursue a degree in Library and/or Information Services.

Warrior CPR Scholarship, \$500

GLHS Senior; minimum 2.5 GPA at the end of the 1st trimester senior year; planning to study Emergency Medical Technology/Paramedic; preference for participation in EMT EFE; consideration for participation in Medical Technology EFE; financial need.

Jack Weber Memorial Scholarship, \$500

GLHS Senior; minimum 2.5 GPA at the end of the 1st trimester senior year; must show involvement in athletics and exhibit a dedication and pride in their school, home and community, and leadership; full-time enrollment in college.

MIDDLE SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP *application deadline April 12, 2012*

James R. Ryan Family Foundation Middle School Scholarship, \$8,000 per year, renewable up to \$32,000

GLMS 8th Grade Student; minimum 3.0 GPA at the end of the 2nd trimester 8th grade; must have demonstrated potential for academic success and plan to enroll in a four-year college or university; must attend Gull Lake Community Schools and graduate from GLHS with a cumulative 3.0 GPA; financial need.
