Award

\$2,500; non-renewable (two scholarships available)

Eligibility Criteria

The applicant must be a graduating Gull Lake High School or Community Schools senior who is an active volunteer in the community, and plans to attend an accredited college, university, or trade school. Financial need will be considered.

Application Instructions

Fully completed applications must be submitted electronically by Friday, March 1, 2024.

Applications for the Jill Adamski Memorial Scholarship must include:

- The GL Community Schools Foundation application completed for this scholarship through Google Forms;
- A letter of recommendation from a Gull Lake High School teacher or coach uploaded onto your Google Forms scholarship application;
- A brief, typewritten essay that includes a description of how academics, athletics and volunteerism shaped you as a person; how your community service has positively impacted the lives of others; and how this award will financially make a difference in your college plans uploaded onto your Google Forms scholarship application;
- Your high school transcript uploaded onto your Google Forms scholarship application.
