Award

\$1,500; non-renewable

Eligibility Criteria

The applicant must be a graduating Gull Lake High School senior who has attained a minimum overall 3.0 GPA at the end of the first trimester of the senior year. The applicant must intend to be a full-time student at an accredited Michigan university or college in the fall following high school graduation, and be pursuing a career in one of the following fields: Business Administration, Engineering, Packaging, and/or Supply Chain Management. It is recommended that the applicant be an active member of extra-curricular clubs (such as DECA, National Honor Society, foreign language club, Robotics, Debate and Model UN, Volunteers, etc.) and have participated in varsity athletics. Community service and/or part-time employment is a plus.

Application Instructions

The following must be submitted to the Gull Lake High School Guidance Office by February 22, 2019, 3 pm:

- One completed copy of the Scholarship Application Cover Page with the box marked for this scholarship
- One completed copy of the Scholarship Application
- A written recommendation from a Gull Lake teacher, administrator, varsity coach, or employment supervisor
- A one-page, typewritten essay including biographical information demonstrating participation and leadership in academics, athletics, community service, and/or work.
