He supported Gull Lake Schools and assisted in the selection of equipment for the education of the high school students in machining and grinding. He also trained many people within his own business. He was an avid hunter, fisherman and sailor, as well as a devoted husband, father and grandfather.

### **Award**

\$1,000; non-renewable

### **Eligibility Criteria**

The applicant must be a graduating Gull Lake Community Schools senior who is planning to enroll in an accredited college, university, trade, or vocational school as a full-time student and planning to pursue a career in engineering or the trades. The applicant must have a minimum 2.5 GPA at the end of the first trimester senior year. The applicant must demonstrate financial need.

- An essay describing your personal aspirations, career goals, and how this scholarship will make a financial difference for you, included in your Google Forms scholarship application;
- Your high school transcript uploaded onto your Google Forms scholarship application.
