



## **WARRIOR CPR SCHOLARSHIP**

This scholarship was established in 2010 by the Warrior CPR Fund Committee. The Warrior CPR Fund has sponsored CPR Blast training in the Richland-Gull Lake area and purchased CPR training materials, aids, and equipment.

### **Award**

\$500; non-renewable

### **Eligibility Criteria**

The applicant must be a graduating Gull Lake High School senior who is planning to enroll in an accredited college, university, or trade school as a full-time student to pursue a career providing lifesaving first-responder emergency care. Preference will be given to those participating in the Emergency Medical Tech EFE Program. Consideration will be given to those participating in any of the Health Sciences EFE Programs. Consideration will also be given to those planning to pursue another medical career such as nursing, fire safety, etc. The applicant must have a minimum 2.5 GPA at the end of the first trimester senior year. The applicant must demonstrate financial need.

### **Application Instructions**

Fully completed applications must be submitted electronically by midnight, Friday, February 26, 2021.

Applications for the Warrior CPR Scholarship must include:

- The GL Community Schools Foundation application completed for this scholarship through Google Forms;
- A letter of recommendation from a Gull Lake High School teacher or coach, uploaded onto your Google Forms scholarship application;
- An essay describing how this scholarship will make a financial difference for you, included in your Google Forms scholarship application;
- Your high school transcript uploaded onto your Google Forms scholarship application.
