Award

\$3,000; non-renewable

Eligibility Criteria

The applicant must be a graduating Gull Lake High School senior who is planning to enroll in an accredited college, university, or trade school as a full-time student. The applicant must have a minimum 3.5 GPA at the end of the first trimester senior year and must be a four-year participant in Gull Lake Band and/or PAC.

Application Instructions

Fully completed applications must be submitted electronically by Friday, March 1, 2024.

- The GL Community Schools Foundation application completed for this scholarship through Google Forms;
- A letter of recommendation from a Gull Lake teacher or individual familiar with the applicant, uploaded onto your Google Forms scholarship application;
- An essay answering the question, "What person, event, or experience has shaped or prompted your goals for the future?", included in your Google Forms scholarship application;
- Your high school transcript uploaded onto your Google Forms scholarship application.
