Glen Hedin the Laurie Makin Cartwright Scholarship

Since 2010, the Cartwright family has honored the memory of their daughter, Laurie Makin Cartwright, with a scholarship in her name through the GLCS Foundation. Laurie was a 2009 graduate of Gull Lake High School and was active and passionate about both the Performing Arts and the Marching Band programs throughout her time in high school.

The decision to honor Laurie through an academic scholarship was inspired by her love of children. Laurie had wanted to pursue a career in family law, and a scholarship seemed like a great way to impact young people and their futures.

For the first six years, the family funded the scholarship by holding an annual golf tournament. The scholarship is now funded through a unique philanthropic group of friends that privately funds different causes through a variety of ways, from silent auctions to 50/50 raffles during the year.

The first scholarship was \$500, and it has increased over the years to a now amazingly generous \$3,000 annually, which is incredibly impactful for the recipient.

The family has requirements for candidates: the applicant must be a graduating Gull Lake High School senior who is planning to enroll in an accredited college, university, or trade school as a full-time student; The applicant must have a minimum 3.5 GPA at the end of the first trimester senior year and must be a four-year; participant in Gull Lake Band and/or PAC.

The family personally selects each recipient, basing their decisions on "trusting their gut

instincts" while reviewing their choices, stating that it's often hard to decide on just one student. They enjoy staying in touch with students they help and followed their first scholarship recipient, Matt Vosters, and his journey all the way through medical school. It's all about helping students in Laurie's memory.

Selfless generosity like this speaks volumes about the Cartwrights and many of the families and organizations behind scholarships given in memory of others. The GLCS Foundation is privileged to facilitate these commemorative
